HIGHER EDUCATION QUALIFICATION EXPLAINED



Higher National Certificates (HNCs) and Higher National Diplomas (HNDs) are more practical than a traditional degree which means that you will gain valuable skills for the workplace. By choosing the HNC/HND route to achieving your higher education qualification you can benefit from developing employability skills to prepare you for a new career or to help you to progress in your current work.

A Foundation Degree is a Level 5 qualification - equivalent to the first two years of a degree level programme - that combines work based learning and academic study.

A Top-up Degree provides the opportunity to build on your HND or Foundation Degree and receive an Honours Degree by completing a final year of study.

Teacher Education courses are available to study on a parttime route over 2 years. The Certificate in Education and Post-Graduate Certificate in Education (PGCE) qualifications at Riverside College provide a thorough introduction to teaching within the Further Education and Skills Sector. You may also be able to undertake your teaching experience at Riverside College.

Higher Apprenticeships allow you to develop your skills to the highest standard and achieve qualifications at Level 4 and above through a mix of on and off-the-job training.

ENGINEERING

HNC in Engineering

This is a specialist work related qualification that covers all of the key knowledge, understanding and practical skills required in the engineering sector. It is considered nationally by employers to be one of the benchmark qualifications for the industry. This qualification provides the education and training for engineers and technicians who are either employed at or are aspiring to work at a professional level in a variety of engineering roles.

Careers in Engineering

Employers place a high value on individuals who possess a Higher National Certificate (HNC) and it can open up higher level jobs within the industry or lead directly to a pay rise or a promotion with your current employer. Completion of the course may also lead to further study on a HND or degree programme in Engineering.

Applicants with professional experience will also be considered on an individual basis.

COMPUTING & IT

HND in Computing

There is an increasing demand for people to work in IT, software and computer services in the UK and beyond. It is fast becoming one of the most dynamic sectors, with the UK Games Industry being one of the largest in Europe.

Whether you are already working in IT and want to progress, or would like to gain a higher level qualification to kick start your career in IT, the HND in Computing will allow you to gain leading edge skills through a nationally recognised qualification awarded by Pearson. You may be able to gain industry qualifications as well as your main course.

Careers in Computing & IT

This course will prepare students for employment in a range of occupations including: e-commerce, software development, IT project management, multimedia, website development, networking and many more.

Entry Requirements:

- Level 3 Certificate in Counselling and GCSE English Language at a minimum of Grade C/ Grade 4 (or equivalent).
- An enhanced satisfactory DBS check
- Two references (one from an academic source).

COUNSELLING

Foundation Degree in Counselling (FdSc)

This course will provide in depth professional training in counselling skills and theory. You will also develop a sound understanding of professional, legal and ethical issues.

Work placement is an integral part of the Foundation Degree in Counselling. This focuses upon the development and application of a range of work based competences and will prepare you to make the transition from learner to counsellor. 100 supervised placement hours will be completed in years 2 and 3.

Successful completion of this course means that you will have achieved qualified practitioner status and will be eligible for employment as counsellors. Graduates may have the opportunity to complete a BSc (Hons) Counselling at Riverside College.

The Foundation Degree in Counselling at Riverside College received a 100% taught satisfaction rate in the National Student Survey 2018.

- Level 3 Certificate in Counselling or related qualification and GCSE English Language at a minimum of Grade C/ Grade 4 (or equivalent).
- Experience of working in an environment with children for a minimum of one year.
- An enhanced satisfactory DBS check
- Two references (one from ar academic source).

Foundation Degree in Counselling Children and Young People (FdSc)

The Foundation Degree in Counselling Children and Young People is an innovative programme that provides education and training for working therapeutically with children and young people from early years to young adulthood using a variety of therapeutic approaches.

Successful completion of this course means that you will have achieved qualified practitioner status and will be eligible for employment as a counsellor working with children and young people.

Graduates may have the opportunity to complete a BSc (Hons) Counselling at Riverside College.

Counselling children requires practitioners to have an in-depth understanding of child and adolescent development theory, child psychiatry, safeguarding and child protection policies.

Start Date: September **Duration:** 1 year

Days/Evenings per week: 1 day

Entry Requirements:

- A Counselling Diploma or Foundation Degree that consists of no less than 400 hours of training and a minimum of 100 hours of supervised counselling practice
- Two written references, one from an academic source if possible.
- A personal statement and a GCSE Grade C/4 in English (or equivalent).

Top-Up BSc (Hons) Counselling

This course has been specifically designed for counsellors who are already qualified to Diploma or Foundation Degree level. It provides an opportunity for you to deepen your knowledge of counselling theory and practice and to develop expertise in areas of specific interest.

To achieve the BSc (Hons) Counselling Degree you need to demonstrate a high level of academic competence. This will be achieved through written assignments and the completion of a research dissertation which explores a topic of your choice.

Foundation Degree in Counselling (FdSc) - 3 years

HEALTH AND SOCIAL CARE

Foundation Degree in Health and Social Care (FdSc)

This course offers you the opportunity to develop core transferable skills and knowledge relevant to health care, social care and public health to enable you to gain employment in an area of your choice.

Employability skills are embedded throughout the award, with a clear focus on how the modules you study can be applied to the workplace. You will be expected to undertake paid or voluntary work experience in a related healthcare setting throughout the duration of the course.

Top-Up BSc (Hons) Health and Social Care

This year long course offers students with a level 5 qualification the opportunity to top up your qualification to a full bachelor's degree.

Throughout your studies you will be taught by friendly, knowledgeable teachers who have been employed in either health or social care and are well equipped to help you relate your study topics to current policy and practice.

- A Levels in related subjects such as PE or Biology.
- GCSE English and maths at a minimum of Grade C/ Grade 4 (or equivalent).
- Applicants with industry/ professional experience will also be considered on an individual basis.
- Current satisfactory enhanced DBS.

SPORT

Foundation Degree in Sport Coaching and PE (FdSc)

This course will provide in depth professional theory with the opportunity to progress to employment within the Sport, Leisure and Educational industry in a wide range of roles. It aims to provide a stimulating learning environment where students will develop a sound understanding of professional, legal and ethical issues. Increasing self-awareness and personal development are also an integral part of the course.

As a sports student you will also have access to our state of the art Sport facilities in our new IDEA Centre at Cronton Campus and will work closely with our external partners to make sure you develop the skills employers want.



Start Date: September **Duration:** 1 year

Days/Evenings per week: 2 ½ days per week

Entry Requirements:

- A UK Higher National Diploma or relevant Foundation Degree within a sport related discipline
- GCSE English and maths at a minimum of Grade C/ Grade 4 (or equivalent).
- Current satisfactory enhanced DBS.

Top Up BA (Hons) Sport Coaching and Sport Development

The aim of this 1 year course is to top up your Foundation Degree or HND Sport to a BA (Hons) and maximise your employability. It will prepare you for employment in a range of careers including PE teaching, sports development and sports coaching.

Foundation Degree in Sport Coaching and PE (FdSc) - 2 years Top Up BA (Hons) Sport Coaching and Sport Development - 1 year

Careers in Sport

You will have the opportunity to progress into a wide range of sport related careers, most commonly teaching, coaching, fitness instruction and sports development.

Start Date: September **Duration:** 2 years

Days/Evenings per week: ½ day per week

Entry Requirements:

- Full Level 3 qualification (Evidence of a suitable work experience will be considered.)
- GCSE English and maths at a minimum of Grade C/ Grade 4 (or equivalent) or demonstration of Level 2 competence in English and maths.
- Applicants must be employed for at least four hours per week in an appropriate educational role and setting. This employment may be paid or voluntary.
- Current satisfactory enhanced DBS

EDUCATION

Foundation Degree in Education (FdA)

This course provides an excellent opportunity for teaching assistants, learning support workers and teaching and learning mentors to build on your knowledge and experience of working in education.

It will enhance your understanding of your current professional role and support career progression and professional development. The course is specifically designed for people who wish to combine work and study. In addition to this, the course provides a route towards obtaining a degree and further professional qualifications.

The Foundation Degree in Education at Riverside College received a 100% taught satisfaction rate in the National Student Survey 2018.

Start Date: September **Duration:** 1 year

Days/Evenings per week: ½ day per week

Entry Requirements:

- Successful completion of the Foundation Degree in Education/ Early Childhood Studies at a Staffordshire University partner college enables you to progress directly onto the BA (Hons)
- Alternatively, completion of an equivalent education/early years based Foundation degree from another provider will be considered.
- GCSE English and maths at a minimum of Grade C/ Grade 4 (or equivalent).
- You must be employed for at least four hours per week in an appropriate educational role and setting. This employment may be paid or voluntary.
- Current satisfactory enhanced DRS

Top-Up BA (Hons) Education

This year long course offers students with a level 5 qualification the opportunity to top up your qualification to a full bachelor's degree.

Foundation Degree in Education (FdA) - 2 years

Top-Up BA (Hons) Education - 1 year

Careers in Education

You may progress to employment within family and children centres, care support, educational administration and management, play work, learning support and many other educational contexts.

Alternatively, you may enter primary teacher training through PGCE Primary, Schools Direct, Schools Direct (salaried) and SCITT routes.

TEACHER EDUCATION

Certificate in Education (PCET) - Level 5
Post Graduate Certificate in Education (PCET) - Level 7

This course will provide a generic route for those wishing to follow a teaching career in the Further Education and Skills Sector, for example further education colleges, sixth form colleges, work based learning, adult and community learning, the Police, Prison and Fire Services, the National Health Service and also across the many private sector training companies.

In addition, there are now teaching opportunities in some schools and academies for post-compulsory teachers, particularly for teachers who can offer a vocational subject.

You will study with trainee teachers from a variety of educational settings. Paid or voluntary teaching experience is a key feature of the course. You may also be able to undertake your teaching experience at the College.



Careers in Teacher Education

Upon completion, successful teachers can undertake a period of professional formation leading to the achievement of Qualified Teaching and Learning Status (QTLS).

If you have completed the Certificate in Education you may be eligible to progress onto a degree level course in Education.

If you have completed your PGCE you may be eligible to progress on to a Master Degree in Education.

PRE UNIVERSITY COURSES

If you do not have the qualifications or experience required, or are not quite ready to study on a higher education programme, we have a wide range of courses designed to prepare you for higher education courses with us or at university.

Level 2 Preparation for Access

This is a one year programme designed for anyone who needs to build up their English, maths and/or science GCSE profile in order to gain entry on to their chosen Access pathway. You will also be prepared for university study through our study skills programme.

Access to Higher Education Level 3

The Access to Higher Education (HE) Diploma is a one year level 3 qualification which prepares you to study at university level. Our access pathways can progress you on to many careers, such as: _____

- > Social Work including Youth Work
- Forensic Psychology and Forensic Science
- Working for the Criminal Justice System
- Nursing Adult, Children's and Mental Health
- > Midwifery
- Physiotherapy, Occupational Therapy, Paramedics

Award in Education and Training

The 12 week programme covers the basics of teaching in continuing and adult education including how to plan sessions, motivate learners and use a variety of assessment methods. After this programme may be eligible to progress on to the Certificate or Post Graduate Certificate in Education.

Level 2 and 3 Counselling Courses

The Level 2 Certificate in Counselling is a 15 week part time course, and the Level 3 Diploma in Counselling is a one year part time course. After successful completion of the Level 3 Diploma in Counselling students can progress on to one of the Foundation Degrees in Counselling and the top up to full degree.



Professional AAT Accounting

The AAT (Association of Accounting Technicians) qualifications are internationally recognised and respected by employers. Studying AAT with us allows you to change your career, progress in your job or make the most of a career break.

This alternative route to gaining nationally recognised higher education qualifications works through a mix of on and off-the-job training. To take on a Higher Apprenticeship you need to be working either in a role with supervisory/management responsibilities or a higher level technical specialist role.

At Riverside College we offer Higher Apprenticeships in:

- > Business
- > Care Leadership
- > Engineering

How does it work?

As a Higher Apprentice you will be assigned a tutor/assessor who will visit you in your workplace regularly to support you to complete any project work and assess the development or work place competencies.

Alongside this you will attend some group training sessions, the frequency of this varies depending upon the Higher Apprenticeship you are studying.


