Courses FREE for everyone:

- Courses that are listed as FREE without an asterisk (*) are free regardless of your circumstances.
- Courses that are listed as FREE (LCR residents only) are free for anyone who lives in the Liverpool City Region (Liverpool, Halton, Knowsley, St Helens, Sefton and Wirral) regardless of your circumstances.

Fee remission criteria to study for FREE:

Courses that are eligible for fee remission are indicated by an asterisk (*) after the course fee in the guide. These may be free for you if you meet the government's fee remission criteria below:

Entry, Level 1 and Level 2 courses may be FREE if you:

- Live in the Liverpool City Region (Liverpool, Halton, Knowsley, St Helens, Sefton and Wirral)
- Live outside of the Liverpool City Region and are either:
 - unemployed, available for work and in receipt of a state benefit
 - earning less than £18,525 per year/£1,544 per month (gross salary)
 - studying a FULL Level 2 course, are aged 19-23, and have NOT already achieved a FULL Level 2 qualification (equivalent to 5 GCSEs at grade A-C/9-4)

Level 3 courses may be FREE if you:

Live within the Liverpool City Region (Liverpool, Halton, Knowsley, St Helens, Sefton and Wirral) and meet all of the following criteria:

- You do not have a full Level 3 qualification or achieved a full Level 3 qualification prior to 1st April 2021
- You are unemployed, available for work and are in receipt of a state benefit OR earn less than £19,305 per year (gross salary)

If you do not live in the Liverpool City Region you will be required to pay the course fee in full at enrolment

You will be required to provide evidence of address/ salary/benefits for funding eligibility at enrolment.

Student Loans:

Advanced Learner Loans are also available for eligible adults enrolling on courses with a plus sign (+) after the fee.

Paying for your course?

If you are paying for your course you will do so at enrolment by card or cash.

Some courses can be paid for by instalments (indicated by a Δ in the guide) or payment plans. Please enquire at enrolment.

All course fees listed are per year and terms and conditions apply.
