### Fee remission criteria

### to study for FREE:

Courses that are eligible for fee remission as indicated by an asterisk (\*) after the course fee in the guide, may be free for you if you meet the government's fee remission criteria as below:

#### Entry, Level 1 and Level 2 courses may be FREE if you:

- live in the Liverpool City Region (Liverpool, Halton, Knowsley, St Helens, Sefton and Wirral).
- live outside of the Liverpool City Region and are either:
  - unemployed, available for work and in receipt of a state benefit
  - earning less than £18,525 per year/£1,544 per month (gross salary)
  - studying a FULL Level 2 course, are aged 19-23, and have NOT already achieved a FULL Level 2 qualification (equivalent to 5 GCSEs at grade A-C/9-4) (See the course information pages on the

website for **FULL Level 2 qualification** confirmation)

#### Level 3 Courses will be FREE if you:

- are aged 19-23 and do not already have a full level 3 qualification (equivalent to 2 A Levels).
- Do not already have a full level 3 qualification AND are studying one of the courses listed in the box below

### **Advanced Learner Loan**

An Advanced Learner Loan is available to anyone over the age of 19, regardless of individual circumstances, studying a Level 3 or 4 eligible course. The loan will fully cover your fees - with no repayments until you are earning £27,295 or over per year (repayment example: if you are earning £28,000 per year you will pay approximately £5 per month). Courses with a '+' in the fee column are eligible for an Advanced Learner Loan.
