### Qualifications Explained

### How do you like to learn?

At Riverside College, we understand that everyone learns differently. Whether you are hands-on or more academic, we offer a wide range of qualifications to suit your learning style, career goals, and exam grades.

Different types of qualifications on offer to school leavers in this guide:

### Level 1, Level 2, and Level 3 Diploma

Certain subjects begin at Level 1 while others start at Level 2 due to the incorporation of new practical skills. Some students may advance to Level 3, while some might progress onto an apprenticeship to further their training and qualifications.

### **Level 3 Extended Diploma**

This two-year full-time course, equivalent to 3 A Levels, provides practical skills and specialised knowledge in your chosen subject, to help you progress to a degree, degree apprenticeship, or the workplace. You may be assessed via portfolio work, practical assessments, and exams.

### **T-LEVELS**

Technical Qualifications (T Levels) are a Level 3 full-time course, studied over two years, and are equivalent to 3 A Levels. You will spend 80% of the course in college, and the other 20% on a meaningful industry placement. T Levels have been designed with more than 250 leading businesses and employers to give you the knowledge and skills you need to progress on to a degree, degree apprenticeship or into the workplace following your course.



You will be in full-time paid employment and will learn on and off the job to develop your knowledge, skills and behaviours. Off the job learning will be a minimum of 6 hours a week and is often undertaken at the college on day release. You will achieve your apprenticeship by completing an independent End Point Assessment and most apprenticeships are now graded from Pass to Distinction.

### Maths and English

You will study maths and English as part of your programme. If you do not achieve a grade 4 or above in GCSE maths and/or English in school, you will continue to study your GSCE or functional skills in maths and English alongside your course.



#### **Foundation Studies Pathways**

Before you start at Riverside College, we will support your transition with various visits and activities which will help you onto an individual learning pathway enabling you to achieve your aspirations and ambitions.
